



Saturday, October 27 – Philadelphia Mid-Atlantic Mobilization to End the War

Bring All Our Troops Home, Now!

The vast majority of the people in every corner of the country want this war to end, but Washington has failed to take decisive action. With each passing month, nearly 100 service people and countless more Iraqis are killed, some 12 billion of our tax dollars are spent, and the death and destruction continue. Our communities -- from New Orleans to Minneapolis -- are neglected and suffer the consequences. From Vermont to California, from Florida to Wisconsin, the people have spoken: We want this war to end, and we want it to end now! We need to focus our resources on our communities to fund education, healthcare, affordable housing and repair the crumbling infrastructure of our highways and mass transportation systems.
